As all of you are aware, Putin's war continues in Ukraine, which is a great concern of ours, and we are trying to help where help is needed. We have held a couple of fundraisers for the refugees that have fled to Lithuania and to the Birzai region. The funds are being distributed by Pagalbos Centras (Help Center) director, Regina Zidonienė. Regina and the other ladies employed by the center, go out and purchase items needed for the refugee families. These items have included food, shoes, clothes, school supplies, school books, home furnishings, and other basic items needed for everyday life. At this time there are 100 refugees living in Birzai and over 56,000 in Lithuania. Not only were we able to help refugees in the Birzai area, but we were able to help refugees in Estonia. Since our Dear Pastor Andrus and Jelena are now living in Estonia, we were able to help with the refugees that they are helping to serve as well. Andrus and Jelena made up medical boxes for the families that are coming into their area. Please keep all those we serve and love in your prayers as this area is facing some very uncertain times.



Our Village Family projects continue as well. One of the projects has been a new roof for a family. We are so happy and proud of this family, as they installed the roof themselves, with only our help with the cost of the materials. And it looks beautiful! They have bought this home and it needs lots of love, but the roof was a must before they could continue with repairs inside. It's wonderful working together in this way.

One of the other family projects has several steps before being finished. The first step was to have a well drilled for this family. This is now complete and the next step is to install water into the house and then have a bathroom installed for the family of 6. We are looking forward to giving this family a healthier life and hopefully expand to other families in the future. Clean, running water in their homes is so very important.

For the past several years they have supported us in our mission work in Birzai and we have built a strong and loving relationship with these two beautiful souls and lovers of Jesus Christ. So, we pray that God will keep our paths together.



Unfortunately, because of the unrest of the region, we will be unable to travel this summer. We know that God will use our monetary support and prayers to help those in need while we cannot physically be with them.
